

## **\*Non-Resident Parent/Student Attendance Acknowledgement**

Conway School Board directs the superintendent or designee to accept, reject or revoke an application for non-resident admission based upon the standards outlined in Policy and Procedure 3141.

In general, the acceptance of a student into the district will be determine based upon the following factors:

1. If a class or grade has reached the board's optimal or contractual number of students per classroom
2. Whether the district has an appropriate program or service available for the student
3. Student's history of behaviors in their previous school
4. If the student has been expelled from school
5. If the student has siblings attending the school
6. If the student has previously attended the district's preschool
7. If there is a substantial financial Hardship to the district

An application may be terminated at any time if:

1. Information in the application is deemed to be incomplete, false, deceptive or has changed since being turned in
2. The parent/guardian does not assume responsibility for transporting the student to/from school
3. Programs or services are no longer available or benefiting the student
4. Problematic attendance based on school policy 3122 and state law
5. Student's attendance presents a risk to the health and safety of students, staff or the community
6. Student's enrollment results in a programmatic or financial hardship on the district
7. Student's disciplinary record shows a pattern of behavior, or ongoing specific behavior that is disruptive to the educational environment
